TO ATTEND THE PUBLIC MEETING IN PERSON AT THE PHYSICAL MEETING LOCATION

- Members of the public may attend the meeting in person at the physical meeting location, or, alternatively, may watch, listen, or call in to the public meeting by following the instructions below.
- Admission to the physical meeting location is on a first-come, first-serve basis and space is limited.
- Masks are required inside the Physical Meeting Location.

TO WATCH OR LISTEN TO THE PUBLIC MEETING REMOTELY

Press # again. You will automatically be placed on mute and will hear a recorded message advising that if you wish to speak, you should press *9 and the host will be alerted. To provide a public comment, press *9 and see additional instructions below.

TO SPEAK AND PROVIDE PUBLIC COMMENTS REMOTELY DURING THE PUBLIC MEETING

- **Dial 646-558-8656** then input the Meeting ID: **832 8548 8320**, followed by #.
- There is no participant ID. Press # again.
- You will automatically be placed on mute and will hear a recorded message advising that if you wish to speak, you should press *9 and the host will be alerted. This is known as “raising your hand.”
- When the Chair of the meeting recognizes you and calls upon you to speak (identifying you by your name or the last 4-digits of your telephone number), the host will “unmute” you and you will hear a recorded message advising you to press *6 to unmute yourself.
- You should press *6 on your phone to unmute yourself.
- Once you are unmuted, you may proceed to deliver your comments.
- Please provide the following information before delivering your comments: Your Name, Address, and if you are engaged in Lobbying Activities and/or representing an organization.
- Please be sure to be in a quiet area to avoid unnecessary noise.
- A time limit may be imposed for each speaker during public comment.
- Your cooperation is appreciated in observing the time limit.

TO EMAIL YOUR PUBLIC COMMENTS PRIOR TO THE PUBLIC MEETING

Members of the public may email their public comments to the District Manager in advance of the meeting. Please email the District Manager at info@gmssf.com by 12:00 p.m. on the day prior to the meeting with the subject line “PUBLIC COMMENT” and the following information in the body of the email: Your Name, Address, and if you are engaged in Lobbying Activities and/or representing an organization. Please limit your comments to no more than 350 words. At the discretion of the District Board, public comments received via email may be read into the record during the public comment portion of the agenda, if any. .

NOTICE PURSUANT TO §286.0105, FLORIDA STATUTES
